There are 285 million people who are visually impaired worldwide. Of those, 39 million people are blind, 246 million have low or impaired vision. More than 165,000 blind or visually impaired veterans now live among us. Each year, some 7,000 veterans become newly blind or visually impaired and additionally about 13 percent of the evacuated wounded service members have suffered a serious eye injury. Healthcare expenditures per year are 8K dollars higher than the non-affected population. Given the large number of individuals worldwide who suffer from blindness and visual impairment, there is a continued need to develop assistive tools.



**ANTIBIOTICS**

A significant unmet need in health care involves the lack of development of new antibiotics. An increasing number of patients are suffering from bacterial diseases that do not respond to currently available antibacterial drugs. With proper funding TRF is committed to developing a pipeline of opportunities with the greatest potential to keep pace with continued pressures leading to antibacterial resistance.



The most common injury sustained by U.S. troops is literally a silent wound: hearing loss. The TRF has developed a program for re-purposing hearing aids to meet unmet hearing loss needs.
